Branksome Centre and Townsend Youth Centre

What's about

It's a youth action project run by disabled young people. Their aim is to have their voice heard, feel safe and engaged in their community and raise awareness towards disabilities.

Who is involved Young people age groups: 15-18 years old 11-18 years old 18-25 years old .

Fusion Youth Club

What's about

It's a non-alcoholic bar, a safe place for young people where they can hang out and play with their friends, use the basement provided with music devices and instruments, speak out on topics that might affect their lives. **Who is involved**

MARKETING DEPARTMENT

This role takes place in one of the Delta House's office, 56 Westover Road. This venue is the hub of the YMCA housing provision. For this reason the marketing department is in charge to organize, deliver and promote the fundraising events with the purpose of raising money, mainly for the housing, but also for the other projects.

The main tasks can change according to the volunteer's competencies, talents and preferences. Below an example of what he/she could be involved in:

- Support in planning and delivering YMCA fundraising and promotional events.
- Contributing to marketing/fundraising meetings
- Help in producing promotional materials: magazines, posters, videos
- Support in creating and editing photo and video materials
- Assisting with administrative tasks within the office
- Updating social media outlets to promote the work of the organisation (Facebook, Twitter and Instagram).

CHAPLAINCY AND HOUSING

This role, way more than the others, requires a spiritual and selfless personality but don't worry you'll still have a great deal of fun!

The volunteer is involved in different projects within and outside of the YMCA Bournemouth with an aim of supporting the housing team in its job with the residents and the local community.

The main projects the volunteer is involved into are: **Snack and Chat**: informal environment for YMCA hostel residents to have a coffee, snack and socialize

Medical Bus: supervising people waiting to see the doctor, chat with them

Prayer meetings: supporting staff, praying for God's action within YMCA projects and in client' lives

Half-time: service for rough sleepers, serving them coffee, toast, giving them advice to help them get off the streets **Overcomers Outreach**: support group for people struggling with addictions, Christ-centred.

Bible study: informal environment to read Bible with residents and answer their questions.

CHILDREN'S SERVICE



- Assisting children aged
- 2-5years with their care, learning and development needs
- Assisting with the preparation of free flow learning opportunities for all children considering their age and stage of development
- Support with general housekeeping duties and assist in preparing food (if certificated to do so)
- Report all safeguarding concerns to pre-school management
- Contribute to team and room meetings and attend some wider YMCA events and fundraising opportunities where possible
- This role takes place during school time only.

THE LEISURE CENTRE



You don't need to have a former leisure experience as long as you enjoy being active and you like sports in general. This role takes place at the Junction in Broadstone which is the farthest of all the YMCA venues, be ware that you are going to travel 2 hours everyday back ad forward. For this reason you will agree with your line manager a timetable suitable for you needs. The main tasks are:

•Assisting staff to provide after school clubs, preschool coaching sessions, holiday clubs, swimming sessions and crèche which consists of taking care of the children while their parents are using the gym or doing fitness classes

•Assisting with administrative and marketing tasks within the office

•Attending and contributing to team meetings, attending relevant training as required.

HOLIDAY CLUB in Townsend

This project is meant to give the children a fun place where to spend their days off from school. At the same time it gives the parents someone who takes care of their children while they are working. Every volunteer can be involved.
